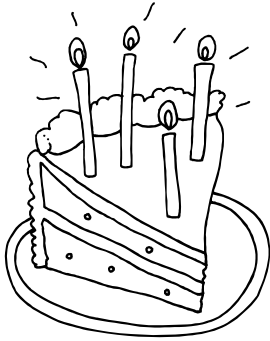

Columbian Club News

Brother Knights, The final numbers from the sale of the property were presented to the membership at Monday's meeting. The sale price was \$350,000, Deductions from that amount are \$5,000 earnest money, \$2,950 for surveying, \$35,000 in commissions to the realtors, \$139.40 for property tax, \$50 attorney's fees, \$1,372 title transfer, \$2,625 State Tax, \$385 county tax, \$295 transaction fee leaving a final balance of \$302,183.60. A motion was passed to immediately transfer \$300,000 over the the KofC account to be invested in the Kalamazoo Diocesan Bank at 4% interest until the council decides on a long-term investment strategy. A resolution regarding the dissolution of the Columbian Club was read and passed.

A resolution of the Blossomland Columbian Club made at the regular meeting held on the sixth day of February in the year of our Lord two thousand six (February 6, 2006).

WHEREAS the real property owned and operated by the Blossomland Columbian Club for the use and enjoyment of the membership of Knights of Columbus Immaculate Heart of Mary Council #1120 has been sold and

WHEREAS the Knights of Columbus Immaculate Heart of Mary Council #1120 has secured a new location for it's meetings and functions at the SS John and Bernard Parish Hall and

WHEREAS there is no longer a need for a separate home corporation to hold real property for the council and

WHEREAS the board of directors, having sought advice from legal and financial counsel as well as advice from officers of the Michigan State Council and those parties concur that there is no need to maintain a home corporation

BE IT RESOLVED that the Blossomland Columbian Club Incorporated shall be dissolved and it assets transferred to Knights of Columbus Immaculate Heart of Mary Council #1120 in accordance with Article XX Section II of its bylaws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the dissolution of the corporation shall be completed no later than April 15th, 2006 upon the filing of it's final tax return in accordance with the advice provided by the corporation's accountant.
