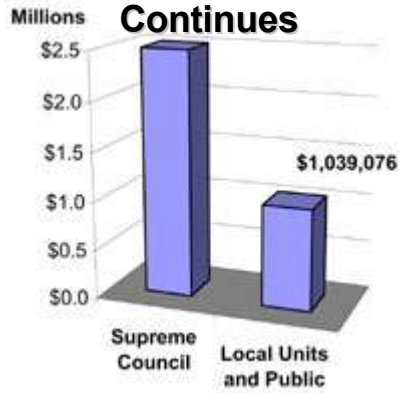

## KofC Katrina/Rita Relief Continues

**Knights** and others have added \$1,039,076 to the Order's Gulf States disaster relief effort. That's in addition to the \$2.5 million committed by the Supreme Council. When donations by local councils and assemblies and the public exceed \$2.5 million, each additional dollar above that amount will be matched by the Supreme Council if received by Nov 1. Of the \$2.5 million already committed by the Supreme Council, \$250,000 has been distributed to Catholic Charities in affected areas, and \$1.25 million will be used to assist those displaced and made indefinitely homeless. An additional \$1 million has been set aside to rebuild the estimated 130 Catholic schools destroyed or seriously damaged by the storm and its aftermath.
